CAFC are a long standing Sussex community club, established in 1894. We have teams ranging from U6's all way through to our Men's first team playing step 4 level.



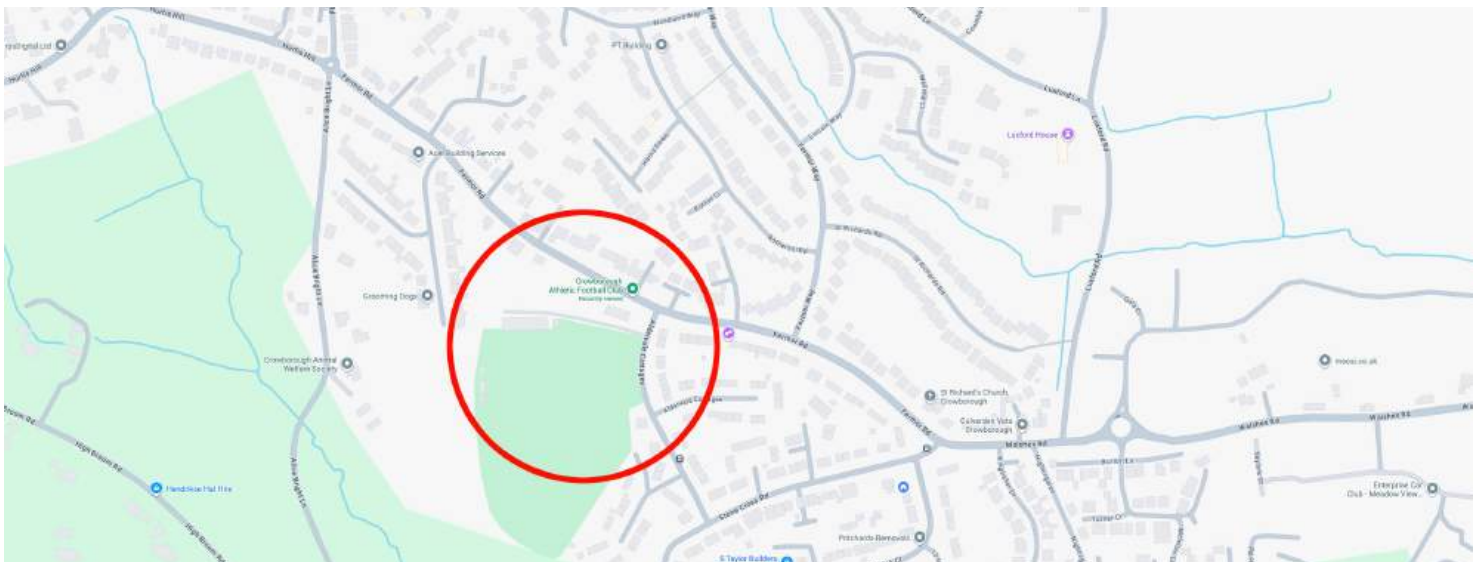
